

# The MAATA Distinguished Young Professionals Award

### **Award Overview:**

The MAATA Distinguished Young Professionals Award is to honor and recognize high quality young professionals (YPs) that have made an immediate and definitive impact on the local, District (3), and/national level of the athletic training profession.

# **Award Eligibility:**

- Nominee must be within first 12 years of profession after initial BOC certification.
- Nominee must reside within District three.
- Nominee must hold current BOC certification.
- Current members of the MAATA YPC committee will not be accepted.

# **Award Application Requirements:**

- To be considered for this award, each nominee must have a complete award application:
  - Nominating athletic trainer must complete the online award nomination form
  - Nominees will be asked to supply an update resume

## **Deadlines:**

Completion of application materials including online form and resume must be submitted by November 30<sup>th</sup> for consideration.

#### **Selection:**

Winners will be selected by the MAATA Young Professionals Committee.
