

How to Apply for Volunteering in MAATA



To apply for a volunteer position (either on a MAATA committee or representing the MAATA to an NATA committee) the applicant must submit the following to District Secretary Jason Mitchell at D3sectry@gmail.com

- A letter specific to the volunteer position desired (why you want this specific position and how you can contribute to this particular committee)
- An updated resume/vita
- Include BOC, NPI and state regulation numbers
 - Note: Your state regulation number (if applicable) **MUST be clearly identified** as regulations for ATHLETIC TRAINING. If your regulation is under a medical or therapy organization, you may state that, but clearly identify this as your state ATHLETIC TRAINING regulation number

Duties:

- Be in and remain in good standing with the BOC and state regulatory agency
- Participate on conference calls for the committee
- Participate fully in all committee activities assigned
- Review and sign the commitment to serve form (depending on the committee you are volunteering for, it will be either a MAATA representative to the NATA, or member of an MAATA committee)
- Attend all in—person meetings for the committee (usually NATA committee representatives at Joint Committee in Dallas in January; at NATA in June)
- **Chairs** of MAATA committees, and MAATA representatives to NATA committees:
 - Submit the Committee Annual report to the MAATA Executive Council (due the first week of May)
 - Present information to the membership at our Annual Business Meeting at the Spring Symposium (May), if new and relevant information is available
